The Plan of the Month contains information on official and unofficial matters within the Squadron. It is distributed under the authority of the Commanding Officer and all personnel are charged with knowledge and adherence to the contents of this document. Any questions regarding the Plan of the Month should be addressed through the chain of command.

Standing Orders and Guidance

NO electronics (eg: iPods, PSPs, PDAs) may be brought to drill by Cadets. Any devices found will be secured by the staff until the end of the drill weekend. Cell phones are authorized to be brought in case of emergency, but will remain OFF during drill hours. If a Cadet must be contacted at drill in case of an emergency, call the duty phone or command phone numbers. The Commanding Officer may approve exceptions to this order if it is deemed in the best interests of the Squadron.

ALL Cadets are required to bring to the following to each drill:

- PT Gear (shirt, shorts, appropriate shoes)
- Water bottle or canteen
- Note-taking supplies (pen/pencil and paper)
- Motivation and a positive attitude

ALL personnel should arrive at the drill location NO LATER THAN 0745.

ALL personnel are required to attend 75% of drills. The chain of command must be notified in advance of any planned absences. The Commanding Officer has the final authority for whether an absence is excused or not.

ALL personnel are encouraged to recruit new Cadets and adult leaders to the Squadron. The Recruiting Officer should be notified of any potential Cadet recruits. The Commanding Officer will handle any potential adult recruits.

Parents and friends are always welcome to attend the monthly awards ceremony and to visit drills held at NAF Washington. Visits to drills held offsite should be coordinated through the OMBUDSMAN at least one week ahead of time.

All personnel should be using their issued Corsairs email account for any official Sea Cadet business. A great deal of information is put out via email and you should check your account at least once a week. Notify the chain of command of any problems accessing your email account.

Department Notes

Executive Officer

This drill is going to be used to prep for the Field Training Exercise (FTX) in APR. Classes will cover topics you will need to know during the FTX. Pay attention because you will see this material again.

Supply will issue out as many Camouflage Utility Uniforms (CUUs) as we have in stock. If you already own CUU pieces bring them to drill so they can be checked. You will not be required to wear CUUs to the FTX. Utilities are still an acceptable uniform. Ghostriders will all be wearing Utilities per NLCC regulations.

Training Department

Cadets that still owe coursework can send it in between drills to courses@cmcorsairs.com or turn in hard copies during drill. Course assignments will now only be accepted on the answer sheet in the back of the course or on the squadron standard answer sheet. If you do not have a copy of the answer sheet contact the Training Dept.

Black Aces and Ghostriders

If you have not received a Drill Schedule letter, you must inform your LPO so one will be printed for you. The letter has all drill dates from now and up to June 2010 as well as contact information for your DivO and LPO. As a general reminder, it is your responsibility to know when drill is scheduled and muster in to your LPO. Please continue to work on your course work; all course work must be turned in to your DivO if you are submitting it at Drill. If you need to take a test for the NLCC Syllabus or one of the Petty Officer Exams, inform your DivO so it can be arranged with the Training Department. Finally, please bring in copies of your report cards and honor roll awards (if you have them) so that you might be awarded for an Academic Achievement ribbon as well as any documentation for Student Service Learning hours to receive a Community Service ribbon. Please refer to the NSCC Awards Manual for ribbon qualifications. If you have any questions, please email or call your Division Officer.

Sundowners

Sundowners should be working on your requirements for completing the Indoc program. Sea Cadets must complete and pass their BMR and League Cadets must complete and pass their Part I Coursework and Exam. All Cadets are required to undergo a uniform inspection for both utilities and dress uniforms. Make sure you have all required uniform pieces and that they fit. All Cadets are also required to undergo a drill inspection and a Physical Fitness Test. You can practice for these outside of drill. All Cadets must take a cumulative exam based on the classes taught during the drill weekends. Attendance in class on drill weekends is required. Therefore, if you miss a class, you will be required to remain in Sundowners until that class is taught again. Keep working hard and if you have any questions do not hesitate to contact your LPO or DivO.
